Operative Magick is the doing of Mischief by the Devil. Witches who make Distinguishes into the Good and Bad Witch commonly called the Black witch or binding witch, in imitation of the devil power of Binding (of sec. 6.) is one who by a League with the Devil is affected by him to work plain Mischief. The Good Witch (commonly called the White Witch or Unbinding Witch as being able to Undo what the other hath done) is he or she who with Diabolical Means to do good, as to heal persons Loops or Vines infrequent mount, and to discover who can be witches and by whom such probably word the Philistines whom King Asa fought to free the Israelites a Malady in his foot, 2 Chron. 16. 12. But that form of a good witch is very Improper, for all who have Commerce with Satan are Certainly bad. Some who are Impoverished only to hurt persons and inflict Diseases Mal. Malefic.
