The Actions of witches Respect either themselves
 and how they act to behave towards their Infernal Ma-
 -lor, or Govern others, perhaps what they are to do to them
 As to their Actions of the first kind, the Devil would
 have his Disciples to give in their addresses to him the
 like former Addressing to his Devils, that God Requires of
 his servants. For they meet together in great Numbers
 he not publicly, at which Meetings called their sabbats
 he teaches them to act all Manner of Mischief and De-
 -mands an Account of all their Crimes past proceeding
 Re often in Defiance of God appoints his Witches in
 the Churches 19 Feby, 1675 Catharin Sand Jocol English
 Janet and Agnes Henricks Whom himself makes use of
 the pulpit, and the witches are obliged in the form of
 -tation to kiss his posteriors 20 January 1592 Agnes

 -cises or hanging lumps of flesh upon sacred places of

 or drawing of Blood, is probably a Diabolical Ceremony or
 -sacrament, to confirm the Hellish Covenant by such a Sal-
 -of Blood: and perhaps the familiar do it in sucking the
 Witches, by the same Venomous quality into her, which by
 working upon her Imagination and spirits, fits her for
 the work of Bewitching. It is said, that witches pay some
 thing Annually to their familiars or pipes, for Redem-
 -ing them from Stript upon the Account of Obsequies or Mo-
 -performances of their tasks or duties Enjoyed them by

 Backs was toward him 29 Decemb. 1643 Margate London
 19 July 1675 Janet Henricks. Two Women witches confessed
 that when the Unclean spirit the Devil polluted their bodies
 his Nature was cold 19 July 1675 Janet Henricks & Catharin
 Sand. Another who had Carnal Copulation with him
 owned, that he lay heavy above her like an ox, and not
 like another Man. Devils who in the shape of Men hit
 Women termed faucis, are called by the old Gauls Dely
 -sior lib. 5. Bern. Demonom. lib. 2 cap. 7. Whome
 Doctor Edward (Disc. 3 on the White i of the Cross) says
 that the Vulgar Exorcism or Incantation Dis-
 -take you in use among some, may one the rise to that
 Name, probably Derived to the English from the Gauls
 whose offspring they are. Devils who in the shape of
 Women prostitute themselves to Men, are called Succubi.
 Somedays any Carnal Copulation of Devils with witches,
 and asport it to be a most Pleasure as Phylarch in the life
 of Numa
