

treason and the Coiners Consentors and Aidors are to be taken and regarded as offenders in treason Importing from any foreign Nation the Counterfeit coin of this Kingdom (being it to be false Money) for Merchandise or Making payments, it is high treason cl. 25 Edw. 3 cap. 2 the fact is to be proved to be actually paid away or Merchandise with all things this sect. 69. The words of the law to Merchandise or Making payment Importing only an Intention to do so. But bringing the Counterfeit coin of this Kingdom from Ireland or other place subject to the Crown of Britain is not high treason Stat. pl. Br. 3. Code 3 Just. 18. Hale pl. Br. 2. Hawkins Stat. pl. Because Counterfeiting is punishable there by the laws of our King as much as in Britain But it is not high treason here, by one who did not bring it from a foreign place, it is neither treason nor Misprision of treason but punishable only by fine and Imprisonment Code 3 Just. 18. He who he that allows it know the person that coins it, or helps with Instruments or tools to coin with all, or furnishes with silver for his Coining, and Money is Remitted according to every one of those cases he is guilty of high treason Hol. Rep. 33. For farther Address and prevention of the great and growing Mischief of Counterfeiting Money (which is the sinews of Government) it is high treason for any person (except such as are Employed in the Mint) knowingly to make or mend or assist in the Making or Mending of any parchment Counter parchment, Matrix, Stamp, Die, Pattern or Mould whereby the figure Stamp or Similitude of both or either side of Current Gold or silver Coin shall be made, or to make or mend or assist in the Making or Mending of any Edge for Remitting the Edge of Money with Letters, Gravings or other Marks like these on the Edges of the Kings coin, or any piece for Coinage, or for Struck for cutting Round Blanks of Metal or to make on the Edges of any of the Current coin or Landing the coin of this Kingdom, or any Counterfeit coin Resembling it, with Letters, Gravings or other Marks like these on the Edges of Money coined in the Kings Mint.

It is also high treason for any person to follow gold or silver with gold or silver or any wash or Materials producing the Colour of gold or silver, any coin Resembling the fair count coin of this Kingdom, or any Blanks Blanks of base Metal or counterfeit gold or silver of the face of White Money, or silver or silver Blanks to be coined into pieces Resembling the fair count coin of this Kingdom. It is also high treason knowing to buy, sell hire or Concoak, or to have in his house post: Office, without Lawfull Authority or execution of the Seal of Justice, without Lawfull Authority, or to convey or assist to Convey Instruments before Witnesses, or to convey or assist to convey out of any of the Kings Mints any of the said or other tools Instruments or Engines used about Coining Money, or any full part of such Instruments, or to receive hire or Concoak of the same. The Counterfeiter procurer aidor and a Helper of any of the fore said offenders, is guilty of high treason. 8th of W. 3 cap. 25. joint 7th. cap. 25.

10th For Preferring the sovereignty, and dignity of the Imperial Crown from Danage, by Lawless Infrachment and usurpation of the Pope of Rome, and the tampering of his running agents and Ministers: it is high treason to execute or publish within his Majesty his Dominions any Bull or Instrument obtained from the Bishop or See of Rome; or to promise or willingly accept of absolution from thence; or to withdraw any from the Protestants to the Romish Religion; or Move them to permit themselves to be reduced from their Natural obedience to his Majesty to be reduced from their Natural obedience to his Majesty. And such an advice and a help those offenders are equally guilty as themselves 23 Eliz. cap. 1. But it is only a fine to aid Comfort or Maintain the Publication of such Papal Bulls, or the promise or tender of absolution from Rome after committing the offence. 24th.
