Some parts of the fines for Violation of penal laws are also appropriated to the repairing of high ways; as the half of those for putting breaking pulling up or peeling the bark of young trees, or breaking down or filling up Dikes hedges or Ditches, or leaping or suffering beasts to go over them act 39. 1. 1. Parl. 1. 7. The said Justices of peace &c. are to see to the right Application of all Bequests Bonds or Mortifications to high ways. They may change piecemeal out high ways and estimate the Damage of parties harmed thereby, who are to receive the value in Wert from them in order to get satisfaction from the funds. The Justices of peace are also to call before them all who straiten the high ways and passages to or from any Market town or borough or from any town to the parish Church or Annoy such ways or passages by casting of Ditches and fufies through them act 15. 5. 1. Parl. 22. 6. Or break or abuse them by plowing, laying stones dung or Rubbish peeling or Darning water thereon or other ways, or labours of land on the sides of high ways not fenced with Dike Ditch or Hedge act 16. 1. 1. Parl. 2. Ch. 2. And to punish and fine the offenders.
